NGOs reach out to flood-affected

GUWAHATI, Aug 27 - A flood relief camp was organised jointly by the Dimoria College Students' Union (DCSU) and the NSS unit of Dimoria College, Khetri with support from WAY Foundation, Guwahati in Lahorighat area of Morigaon district on August 25.

The camp was led by Anup Dutta Baruah, Programme Officer, NSS. Relief materials were distributed in Batorbori, Singaherua and Jengorbori under Lahorighat revenue circle. Altogether 279 households were benefitted. The team also distributed sanitary pads among women. They conducted an awareness drive about menstrual hygiene and proper disposal of used pad.

Rotary Club of Gauhati West also conducted a flood relief camp for the affected people of Rajabori village in Morigaon district and distributed food and cleaning items including 400 litres of milk, 400 liters of bottled water, baby food, biscuits, soaps, bleaching powder, etc., worth Rs 60,000 to 300 families.

Dr Dibakar Kalita, child specialist from Guwahati, who attended the relief camp, said that there was no breakout of any endemic situation till date.

Friends Forever, a women's society visited Kalangpar, a flood-affected village at Mayong and distributed food items, candles, match boxes, dhoop, drinking water, etc., to about a hundred families today.

Marwari Hospitals, Guwahati in coordination with the district administration of Nagaon and Morigaon, deputed a team of medical professionals consisting of specialists from the Department of Obs. & Gynae, Paediatrics and General Medicine along with nursing experts to the two districts. The team of doctors comprising Dr Salma Ferdouse Choudhury, Dr Parimal Ranjan De and Dr Debasish Das along with paramedical staff offered their services to the flood-affected people at Kuthori and at Kaliabor in Nagaon, recently.

Another team of doctors along with paramedical staff offered their services at Kurani Bori Gram Panchayat and Patidoya in Morigaon. Over 800 patients from all age groups were treated and free medicines provided to the needy.

Grief & U, an organisation of Guwahati Refinery, Marketing and Pipeline division, organised a flood relief camp at Murkata and Borpam village at Mayong circle of Morigaon district today.

The team distributed relief material like rice, dal, mustard oil, sugar, candle, match box, chira, potato, onion, water bottle, garments, etc., for 200 flood victims. For school students, pencil, rubber, papers, etc., were distributed. The team was led by Sita Baruah, vice president, Welfare wing.

I also wanted to introduce my organization so that the students of Dimoria College can get a direction on how to work for a change in society.

Humanity Welfare Council (HWC) is a national level, non-profit organization instituted with the primary mission to make India a developed nation. Headquartered in New Delhi, India, we came into existence in 2017. We are working diligently towards our mission through our various projects and programs. We aim to make India a developed nation by 2030 under the umbrella of HWC by dealing with the respective sectors affecting India's growth. We promote sustainable systems as the dream of a developed nation stands unachievable without them.

As we know, the healthcare system in our country is fighting various problems, including the insufficient number of institutions and short-staffed human resources. A few people get expensive, world-class care, while a large part of the population doesn't even get the primary quality care. Over 60% of our population pays out of pocket for healthcare, driving millions into poverty.

Project Global Cure is a Humanity Welfare Council initiative that aims to transform the health care sector in India by providing necessary funds to people in urgent need of medical assistance and advancing the medical system with increased accessibility. We will take up the case, connect them to the concerned medical department, fundraise the required amount for the treatment, get the patient treated for free and we also take care of the after-care for a speedy recovery.

At the end of the session am glad that the students were very enthusiastic, we also had an active discussion on what they thought about the concept that we have started. They were very good listeners as well. It was nice to see their interest to do something for their society on an individual level. I am very proud to share that two PG students, Ms Korobi Das and Ms Daisy Bordoloi from the Economics Dept. of

Dimoria College, Khetri has been actively working with us and connected us to families who have a very weak financial background and wanted immediate attention. Also due to their constant involvement and active support, we could help two children have a healthy future now.

Ms Korobi gave us a case of a 4-year-old girl Tanaya Deka, who was suffering from Local Gigantism due to which her one leg was abnormal. But as we gave immediate attention, we have successfully completed her first surgery in November 2021 and now she is recovering well. Her second and final surgery is due in April 2022. The family is financially very weak and Tanaya's father who is a farmer with a meagre income is the sole bread-winner.

Similarly, Ms Daisy gave us a case of a 6-year-old boy Mousam Dekaraja, who was also suffering from Local Gigantism along with a leg tumour and if not treated immediately he would have lost his leg. We coordinated with the doctors and started the process immediately. His first surgery was successful in October 2021 and now his leg is healing. He will have to go for a few check-ups end of March 2022. His father is a daily wage worker with a very low income and he has to take care of the family all alone.

I am thankful to both the students for taking the initiative and helping us reach the families on time. They were of great help throughout the treatment process, they coordinated and interacted with the respective families and also gave us the required information as and when needed.

A special thanks to The PG Department of Economics, Dimoria College, Khetri for inviting me as a resource person and giving me an opportunity to interact with the vibrant students. The Department played a big role in changing the lives of two little children. I have always respected your efforts to enhance the skills and development of students. Would love to stay connected with the reputed college in future.

I would like to welcome more such students to come up, be a part of our mission and be the change like the famous saying "Be the change you want to see in the world".
