I extend my sincere thanks to the editorial team and all contributors who have made this initiative possible. May this newsletter grow into a cherished chronicle of our college events and achievements.

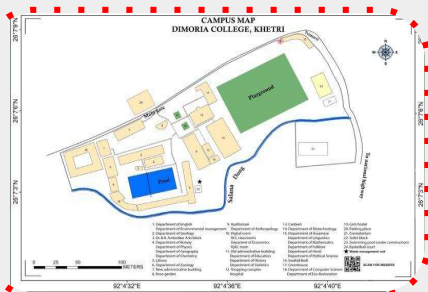

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## Dimoria College at a Glance

With 22 full-fledged departments (in Arts and Science stream) which run 22 Undergraduate courses and 4 Post-Graduate courses, Dimoria College is the torch bearer of higher education in this tribal Dimoria region which is considered as an economically and socially underprivileged tribal belt block. Dimoria College is the brainchild of a group of highly motivated social entrepreneurs who in the seventies dreamt of bringing the higher education to this relatively underdeveloped tribal belt area Dimoria. Led by the indomitable teal of patrons of learning like Late Padmakanta Deka (Founder President), Late Santa Ram Deka (Founder Secretary), Late Prasanna Deka, Late Gopinath Sarma, Late Krishna Kanta Bhuyan, the people of Dimoria started a public campaign for the establishment of a College. With such effort and zeal, Dimoria College was established on 29<sup>th</sup> August 1979. Surrounded by a lush green environment, Dimoria College beholds a unique signature of captivating a sustainable ecosystem within its campus. Many valuable trees and medicinal plants present in the campus make Dimoria one of the only colleges in the region to have such a green and pollution-free campus. Along with it, the campus also holds a pond which comprises of rich aquatic flora and fauna making it one of the most beautiful natural campuses in the region.

The college was conferred Autonomous Status in September 2024 under the provisions of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. This significant milestone has enabled the institution to design a flexible, student-centric curriculum that integrates academic excellence with holistic development. In line with this vision, the college has introduced a range of enriched co-curricular activities aimed at fostering creativity, critical thinking, and essential life skills. The first two Semester Examinations under Dimoria College (Autonomous) were conducted smoothly and transparently, ensuring timely declaration of results and steady academic progression. From the Academic Session 2025–26, the college has fully adopted and implemented its own curriculum under the autonomous framework.

## Academic Council



The first meeting of the Academic Council of Dimoria College (Autonomous) was held on 23rd July 2025, under the chairmanship of the Principal (i/c), Dr. Mahananda Bora. The meeting was attended by the Vice-Chancellor's nominees, Prof. Parag Phukan, and the Governing Body's nominees, Prof. Rajib Handique, Mr. Jayanta Kumar Sarma, Mr. Gopi Kanta Medhi, and Mr. Jyotish Talukdar.

The Council deliberated on and approved the proposals of the Boards of Studies concerning courses of study, academic regulations, curricula, and syllabi, incorporating modifications wherever necessary. It also issued directions regarding evaluation processes and formulated regulations on examinations, admissions, and extracurricular activities.



## Board of Studies



The Board of Studies (BoS) meetings of all departments were conducted between 17th May 2025 and 22nd July 2025 for the preparation of departmental syllabi to be implemented from the Academic Session 2025–26. The syllabi were designed in accordance with the curriculum framework of Dimoria College (Autonomous), developed on the basis of UGC guidelines under NEP-2020. In total, 22 BoS meetings were convened across 22 departments.

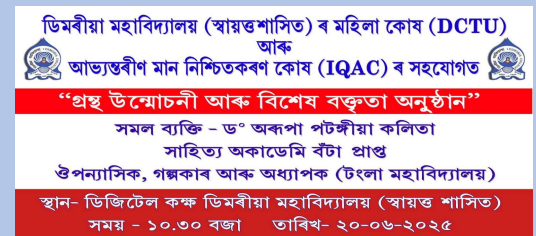
